John 1:35-51

1. The Call to the One Seeking (35-39).
Timing – third day in our look at John the Baptist.
Teacher – John was pointing the way to Jesus.
Transfer – John's disciples learned and changed.
2. The Call to the One Struggling (40-42).
Identification – one discipleship is Andrew.
Invitation – brought Peter to meet Jesus.
Initiation – Jesus gave Peter a new identity.

Discipleship Principle #1: John reminds us that humility is essential to follow the Lord. We will only spend time in God's Word and prayer when we realize we are helpless when we are out of fellowship with Him.

Discipleship Principle #2: Discipleship is nurtured when we learn truth from God's Word and live in conformity to His truth.

Discipleship Principle #3: The measure of discipleship is found in our desire to spend time with the Master.

Discipleship Principle #4: the enthusiasm of the disciple is revealed through evangelism.

Discipleship Principle #5: Although there will be times of struggle, the evidence of discipleship is transformation.
