1	Genesis 1-2	Anthropology	Who made mankind?	God personally and specifically created mankind.
2	Genesis 1:26-27	Anthropology	What does "made in the image of God" mean?	God made mankind unique: we have some of God's own characteristics.
3	Genesis 1:26-31, Ephesians 2:4-10	Anthropology	Why did God make man?	God created man to rule the earth and glorify Him.
4	Genesis 2:7 Psalm 139:13-16 Revelations 20:11-22:5	Anthropology	What is man made of?	God made man both a physical body and immaterial soul
5	Genesis 2:15-24, Ephesians 5:22-33	Anthropology	Why did God make men and women?	God made men & women to each fulfill distinct roles
6	Genesis 11:1-9, Acts 17:26, Galatians 3:28, Revelations 21:24, Revelations 26	Anthropology	Why did God create ethnicity and nations?	God created ethnicity and nations to glorify Himself.

8	Genesis 1:31-3:24	Hamartiology	Why did Adam sin?	Adam deliberately chose to disobey God.

13	Romans 3:9-20, Romans 8:5-8	Hamartiology	Can man please God and save himself?	Man has no ability to please God and save himself.
14	Ephesians 1:3-6	Soteriology	What does God's choice in election mean?	God chose those who would receive salvation & its blessings
15	John 3:16, Romans 5:8, 1 John 4:8-10 Hebrews 2:17	Soteriology	What does atonement tell us about God?	God is just and loving; He is righteous and merciful
16	Matthew 22:13, Isaiah 53:4-11	Soteriology	Why is Christ's death called a sacrifice?	Jesus died as a sacrifice to be God's perfect substitute for elect sinners.
17	1 John 4:9-10, Romans 3:21-26	Soteriology	What did Christ's sacrifice do for those who believe?	Jesus' sacrificial death satisfied God's wrath.
18	1 Peter 1:18-19, Romans 6:15-19	Soteriology	How are Christians ransomed?	Christ's blood was shed as the ransom payment for the sins of the elect.
19	Romans 5:6-11	Soteriology	How does Jesus' death bring reconciliation?	Jesus' death brings peace between God and His people.
20	1 Corinthians 15:1-19	Soteriology	What does Christ's resurrection prove?	Christ's resurrection proves the gospel true and life giving.
21	Matthew 22:14, Luke 24:46-48, Revelations 20:11-21:4	Soteriology	To whom does God offer salvations?	God issues His gracious call of salvation to all mankind.
22	John 3:1-21	Soteriology	What is regeneration?	Regeneration is a special work of the Holy Spirit giving life to dead sinners.
23	Acts 26:1-20, 2 Corinthians 7:9-10	Soteriology	How do sinners repent?	Sinners repent by turning to God from sin with their whole heart and life.
24	Hebrews 11:1-6, Ephesians 2:8-10	Soteriology	What is true saving faith?	Faith is a whole-hearted commitment and trust in Jesus alone for salvation.
25	Ephesians 1:3-14	Soteriology	What is union Christ?	Those who have faith in Jesus have died with Christ, and they now live in Christ.
26	Romans 3:21-28	Soteriology	What is justification?	Those who have faith in Jesus are declared to be righteous before God.
27	John 1:9-13, Luke 11:1-13	Soteriology	What is adoption?	Those who have faith in Jesus are made members of His family and given countless blessings.
28	2 Corinthians 3:12-18, Philippians 2:12-13	Soteriology	What is sanctification?	Sanctification is God's ongoing process of making all Christians more and more holy.
29	John 10:22-30, John 15:1-10	Soteriology	What does perseverance mean?	Good assures believers of future glory, in hope of which Christians live obediently on earth.
30	1 Corinthians 15:35-58	Soteriology	What is glorification?	Glorification is the transformation of the bodied and souls of believers to be like Christ.
